## THEATRE DIRECTOR IN RESIDENCE PERFORMING ARTS

Gordonstoun has a vibrant theatre culture and outstanding facilities. The Ogstoun Theatre is a fully equipped modern theatre and the post offers the Director the opportunity to realise their ideas in production with a fullness rarely seen outside professional theatre. The school mounts a number of productions each year and we strive for exceptionally high standards of work.

The Ogstoun Theatre is equipped with Digital sound and lighting and all of our work is supported by a full time AV and Theatre technician who will facilitate the successful candidate in achieving their vision for performance on the stage.

The school mounts a wide variety of productions each year from large scale musical theatre to smaller student led productions. The post holder will be responsible for directing or overseeing all of the productions taking place through the year as well as managing the theatre arts building (Ogstoun Theatre) and working closely with the Head of Dance & Drama.

## Responsibilities would include:

- Directing at least one major production per team
- Supporting curricular learning and performances in drama and dance (in junior and senior school)
- Organising and running drama activities and clubs throughout the week
- Managing the fabric of the Ogstoun Theatre
- Liaising with incoming theatre groups and performers
- Implementing the Lamda Speech and Drama exams at Gordonstoun
- Support the auditions for the NYT that are held at Gordonstoun annually
- Support with other productions and events held at Ogstoun including the annual Dance Show, Open days and other showcase events.
- General duties in support of boarding school life

This is a 10 month paid appointment (September 2019 - 30 June 2020). On-site accommodation (at a small charge) is available.
