



## *Junior School Learning Support*

Learning Support in the Junior School aims to meet the individual requirements of learners with Special Educational Needs (SEN), but also recognises those who may need additional support at various points through their school life. Our in-class support takes place throughout all year groups, with Years 6, 7 and 8 having the option for Learning Support lessons during French and/or Latin. These lessons are typically for pupils with a recognised SEN that has been identified through an Educational Psychologist report or an in-house assessment carried out by the Head of Learning Support.

Where possible, we try to keep pupils within their classroom environment but in some circumstances, pupils may join a weekly literacy or numeracy group which take part during their lesson. This is always done in consultation with the class teacher, our specialist Learning Support teachers and parents.
